Dear Mr. Perkowski:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) received a notice of intent to modify the above-referenced facility on August 15, 2018.

According to Section 16-50j-71 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, "...any modification, as defined in Section 16-50j-2a of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, to an existing tower site, except as specified in Sections 16-50j-72 and 16-50j-88 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, may have a substantial adverse environmental effect."

Staff has reviewed this exempt modification request for completeness and has identified a deficiency in the above request for exempt modification. The notice of exempt modification cover letter contains incorrect information regarding the location of the facility, property owner, and officials notified.

Therefore, the exempt modification request is incomplete at this time. The Council recommends that Airosmith Development Inc. provide a revised notice of exempt modification with the correct information on or before September 21, 2018. If additional time is needed to gather the requested information, please submit a written request for an extension of time prior to September 21, 2018.

This notice of incompletion shall have the effect of tolling the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) 60-day timeframe in accordance with Paragraph 217 of the FCC Wireless Infrastructure Report and Order issued on October 21, 2014 (FCC 14-153).

RE: Notice of Exempt Modification – Antenna Swap for wireless facility located at 20 POST OFFICE LANE, WESTPORT, CONNECTICUT – CT03XC336 (lat. 41° 07' 24.27" N, long. - 73° 18' 46.93" W)

Dear Ms. Bachman:

Sprint Spectrum, LP ("Sprint") currently maintains wireless telecommunications antennas at the (120-foot level) on an existing (142-foot Monopole Tower) at the above-referenced address. The property is owned by Jay Sherwood, and the tower is owned by AMERICAN TOWER CORPORATION.

Sprint's proposed work involves antenna replacement and tower work. Sprint intends to replace six (6) antennas, and add nine (9) new RRHs onto the tower. All the proposed work is contained within the existing fenced area. Please refer to the attached drawings for site plans prepared by Infinigy Engineering.

Please accept this letter as notification pursuant to R.C.S.A. § 16-50j-73, for construction that constitutes an exempt modification pursuant to R.C.S.A. § 16-50j-72(b). In accordance with R.C.S.A. § 16-50j-73, a copy of this letter is being sent to JAMES MARPE, FIRST SELECTMAN and MARY YOUNG, DIRECTOR OF PLANNING AND ZONING of the Town of Westport. A copy of this letter is also being sent to JUSTINE PAUL the manager for AMERICAN TOWER CORPORATION who manages the tower and a letter is also being sent Jay Sherwood who owns the land.

The planned modifications to the facility fall squarely within those activities explicitly provided for in R.C.S.A. § 16-50j-72(b).

- 1. The proposed modifications will not result in an increase in the height of the existing tower.
- 2. The antennas work is a one-for-one replacement of facility components.
- 3. The proposed modifications will include the addition of ground base equipment as





depicted on the attached drawings; however, the proposed equipment will not require an extension of the site boundaries.

- 4. The proposed modifications will not increase noise levels at the facility by six decibels or more.
- 5. The additional ground based equipment will not increase radio frequency (RF) emissions at the facility to a level at or above the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) adopted safety standard.

For the foregoing reasons, Sprint respectfully submits that the proposed modifications to the above referenced telecommunications facility constitutes an exempt modification under R.C.S.A. § 16-50j-72(b).
