### Decision and Order

Pursuant to the foregoing Findings of Fact and Opinion, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) finds that Sprint Spectrum, L.P.'s proposed sharing of the tower located at 23 Kelleher Court is technically, legally, environmentally and economically feasible, and that the sharing of this tower meets public safety concerns, will avoid the unnecessary proliferation of towers and is in the public interest. Therefore, in compliance with § 16-50aa of the Connecticut General Statutes, the Council orders the shared use of this facility to avoid the unnecessary proliferation of tower structures subject to the following conditions:

1. In mounting its antennas on this tower, Sprint shall employ T-bar mounts to minimize the potential visual impact of the added antennas.
2. If Sprint does not provide wireless services at this facility within one year of date of this Decision and Order, or within one year after all appeals to this Decision and Order have been resolved, or if Sprint ceases to provide wireless services for a period of one year, this Decision and Order shall be void.
3. Any antenna that becomes obsolete and ceases to function shall be removed within 60 days after such antennas become obsolete and cease to function.

We hereby direct that a copy of the Findings of Fact, Opinion, and Decision and Order be served on each person listed below, and notice of issuance shall be published in The Hartford Courant.

By this Decision and Order, the Council disposes of the legal rights, duties, and privileges of each party named or admitted to the proceeding in accordance with Section 16-50j-17 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.
