Dear Ms. Bachman,

T-Mobile currently maintains antennas at the 120' level of the existing 120' Monopole at 160 Deer Run Road, Wilton, CT. The tower is owned by SBA and the property is owned by Westport Broadcasting Co. T-Mobile now intends to install one (1) 25kW backup generator within it's leased space in SBA's compound.

This facility was approved by Docket 03084 by the Siting Council August 31, 2006, with no record of conditions that would restrict exempt modifications. Therefore, this modification complies with the aforementioned approval.

Please accept this letter as notification pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies 16-50j-73, for construction that constitutes an exempt modification pursuant to R.C.S.A. 16-50j-72(b)(2). In accordance with R.C.S.A. 16-50j-73, a copy of this letter is being sent to First Selectwoman Lynne Vanderslice of Wilton, as well as the tower and property owner.

The planned modifications to the facility fall squarely within those activities explicitly provided for in R.C.S.A. 16-50j-72(b)(2).

1. The proposed modification will not result in an increase in the height of the existing structure
2. The proposed modifications will not require the extension of the site boundary.
3. The proposed modifications will not increase noise levels at the facility by six decibels or more, or to levels that exceed state and local criteria.
4. The operation of the replacement antennas will not increase radio frequency emissions at the facility to a level at or above the Federal Communications Commission safety standard.
5. The proposed modification will not cause a change or alteration in the physical or environmental characteristics of the site.

6. The existing structure and its foundation can support the proposed loading.

For the foregoing reasons, T-Mobile respectfully submits that the proposed modifications to the above-referenced telecommunications facility constitute an exempt modification under R.C.S.A. 16-50j-72(b)(2).

Dear Ms. Jamieson:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) received a notice of intent to modify the above-referenced facility on November 5, 2018.

According to Section 16-50j-71 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, "...any modification, as defined in Section 16-50j-2a of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, to an existing tower site, except as specified in Sections 16-50j-72 and 16-50j-88 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, may have a substantial adverse environmental effect."

Staff has reviewed this exempt modification request for completeness and has identified a deficiency in the above request for exempt modification. The cover letter states that the request is for a 15kW diesel fueled generator. However the Site Plans indicate a 25kW diesel fueled generator. The above referenced request for exempt modification contains conflicting information.

Therefore, the exempt modification request is incomplete at this time. The Council recommends that Transcend Wireless provide clarification on the conflicting information highlighted on or before December 7, 2018. If additional time is needed to gather the requested information, please submit a written request for an extension of time prior to December 7, 2018.

This notice of incompleteness shall have the effect of tolling the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) 60-day timeframe in accordance with Paragraph 217 of the FCC Wireless Infrastructure Report and Order issued on October 21, 2014 (FCC 14-153).
