RE: The Connecticut Light and Power Company's Notice of Exempt Modification Pursuant to RCSA § 16-50j-57(a) to an existing energy facility at 143 Carmel Hill Road in the Town of Woodbury, Connecticut ("Notice of Exempt Modification" or "Notice")

Dear Attorney Bachman:

The Connecticut Light and Power Company dba Eversource Energy ("Eversource") received acknowledgement from the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on August 9, 2021 to its Notice that Eversource's proposed modifications at the existing Carmel Hill Substation at 143 Carmel Hill Road in Woodbury would comply with the exception criteria outlined in Section 16-50j-57(a) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies. In its acknowledgement, the Council included conditions regarding the proposed work, including the following;

 The Requestor may file a request for an extension of time beyond the one-year deadline, provided that such request is submitted to the Council not less than 60 days prior to the expiration.

Due to delays in final engineering and development of a constructability plan, the Project requires additional time to complete. Eversource hereby requests that the one-year deadline to complete the Project be extended to June 2023.
