RE: **PETITION NO. 1090A** – Bloom Energy Corporation amended declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed Phase II construction, maintenance and operation of a second customer-side 250-kilowatt fuel cell facility and associated equipment to be located at the Danbury Fair Mall, 7 Backus Avenue, Danbury, Connecticut.

Dear Ms. Grillo:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated July 6, 2022 regarding project changes for the above-referenced declaratory ruling issued by the Council on January 31, 2020. The project changes are as follows:

- a. install a 300-kW fuel cell instead of a 250-kW fuel cell;
- b. reduce the fuel cell equipment area from 900 square feet to 630 square feet; and
- c. use a skid-mount instead of a concrete pad to support the fuel cell.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's January 31, 2020 Declaratory Ruling, the request to modify the project is hereby approved.

This approval applies only to the project changes detailed in the correspondence dated July 6, 2022. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes \$16-50u.
