RE: SUBPETITION NO. 1133-VER-20221221 – Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless eligible facility request for modifications to an existing telecommunications facility located at 221 West Main Street, East Lyme, Connecticut.

Dear Attorney Baldwin:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) hereby approves your Eligible Facilities Request (EFR) to replace Verizon's existing canister antenna at the above-referenced facility pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission Wireless Infrastructure Report and Order, with the following conditions:

- 1. Approval of any changes be delegated to Council staff;
- 2. RF access restriction and caution signage shall be installed at the site in compliance with FCC guidance;
- 3. Written notification to the Council at least two weeks prior to the commencement of site construction activities:
- 4. Deployment of any 5G services must comply with FCC and FAA guidance relative to air navigation, as applicable;
- 5. Within 45 days after completion of construction, the Council shall be notified in writing that construction has been completed;
- 6. Any nonfunctioning antenna and associated antenna mounting equipment, or other equipment at this facility owned and operated by Verizon shall be removed within 60 days of the date the antenna or equipment ceased to function;
- 7. The validity of this action shall expire one year from the date of this letter; and
- 8. Verizon may file a request for an extension of time beyond the one year deadline provided that such request is submitted to the Council not less than 60 days prior to the expiration.

This decision is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the Council and is not applicable to any other modification or construction. All work is to be implemented as specified in the EFR dated December 20, 2022. Any changes to the eligible facility request require advance notification and approval.
