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RE: **SUBPETITION NO. 1133-T-MOBILE-20220124** - T-Mobile sub-petition for a declaratory ruling for an eligible facility request for modifications to an existing telecommunications facility located at 720 Quinebaug Road, Thompson, Connecticut.

Dear Attorney Langer:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) hereby approves your Eligible Facilities Request (EFR) to install an emergency backup generator and associated equipment within an additional lease area at the above-referenced facility pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission Wireless Infrastructure Report and Order, with the following conditions:

1. Approval of any changes be delegated to Council staff;
2. Installation and maintenance of erosion and sediment controls consistent with Site Note 4 on Sheet N-1 of the project site plans dated March 19, 2021; and
3. Written notification to the Council at least two weeks prior to the commencement of site construction activities.
4. Within 45 days after completion of construction, the Council shall be notified in writing that construction has been completed;
5. Any nonfunctioning equipment on this facility owned and operated by T-Mobile shall be removed within 60 days of the date the antenna ceased to function;
6. The validity of this action shall expire one year from the date of this letter; and
7. The Petitioner may file a request for an extension of time beyond the one year deadline provided that such request is submitted to the Council not less than 60 days prior to the expiration.

This decision is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the Council and is not applicable to any other modification or construction. All work is to be implemented as specified in the EFR dated January 20, 2022. Any changes to the eligible facility request require advance notification and approval
