Dear Mr. Galton:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated April 14, 2022 regarding a project change for the above-referenced declaratory ruling issued by the Council on March 9, 2015, and subsequently amended on September 5, 2017 and October 12, 2018.

Pursuant to Condition No. 5 of the Council's Amended Declaratory Ruling dated September 5, 2017 and Condition No. 3 of the Council's Amended Declaratory Ruling dated October 12, 2018, the request to implement a Sheep Grazing Management Plan using rotational paddocks to maintain ground vegetation within the fenceline of the solar facility is hereby approved.

This approval applies only to the project change in the correspondence dated April 14, 2022. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling and Amended Declaratory Rulings are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes §16-50u.
