RE: Non-Compliance with Declaratory Ruling Conditions and Notification of Completion

Dear Attorney Hoffman:

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §§ 4-176 and 16-50k, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) issues Declaratory Rulings for facilities that would not have a substantial adverse environmental effect and would not require a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need. The Council routinely imposes standard conditions when issuing Declaratory Rulings. Furthermore, the Council may add site-specific conditions that require further effort of the petitioning entities to provide written confirmation to the Council that the conditions have been met.

To date, the Council is not in receipt of any communication that site-specific conditions applicable to the above-referenced Declaratory Ruling have been met. The Council is also not in receipt of any notification that construction has been completed. The Council did receive a construction status letter, dated July 30, 2019 stating that the project is substantially constructed and is generating electricity to the grid and will notify the Council of its completion upon termination of the General Permit. To date, however, a completion letter has not been received.

The Council hereby requests compliance on these matters no later than January 13, 2023. If additional time is needed to gather the requested information, please notify the Council in writing.
