The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) received approval from the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) on June 28, 2022 for Sub-Petition No. 1293-BM-01. In its June 28, 2022 letter acknowledging the above referenced Sub-Petition, the Council included conditions, regarding the need for additional time to complete maintenance activities on the above-referenced Sub-Petition based on the following condition:
