I. Introduction:

In accordance with Condition 1 of the March 30, 2017 ruling by the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council") (as set forth in the Council's March 31, 2017 letter) regarding Petition No. 1293, The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy ("Eversource") submits this Sub-Petition.

II. Description of Transmission Work Activities:

Eversource's 1765/1766 Transmission Lines Structure Replacement Project is part of an ongoing maintenance program which evaluates the integrity of its utility structures and implements repair, upgrade or replacement in order to ensure the safe and reliable transmission of power to its customers. Due to asset condition, many structures require replacement on portions of the 1765 and 1766 Lines between Berlin Substation in Berlin to a location just north of Oxford Drive in Middlefield and from a location just south of Lancaster Court in Middletown to West Side Substation in Middletown. The lines share the same right-of-way ("ROW") from a location just south of Lancaster Court to Westside Substation. The 1765 Line in its entirety, is a 115-killovolt line that extends from Berlin Substation to West Side Substation. The 1766 Line in its entirety is a 115-killovolt line that extends from Dooley Substation in Middletown to West Side Substation. Of the structures that will be replaced, 80 structures require a slight increase in structure height to comply with current clearance requirements. These 80 structures to be replaced are a mix of wood H-Frame and monopole structures.

Eversource plans to conduct transmission structure replacement work to remediate wood structure damage caused by structure age, weather, and woodpecker activity. The following work ("Work Activities") will be performed:

Replace 80 existing wood structures with new weathering steel structures. Each
replacement structure will be of the same design as its corresponding existing structure. To
facilitate system reliability of the transmission lines optical ground wire ("OPGW") will be
installed during a future project. Two of the structure replacement locations associated with
Structures 6127 and 6-319 will also be utilized as pull pad locations for the future OPGW
project.

III. No Substantial Adverse Environmental Effect:

Eversource respectfully submits that the proposed modifications would have no "substantial adverse environmental effect" pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-50k, based on the following factors:

- a) All Work Activities would take place in areas within Eversource's property or existing ROW utilizing existing and proposed new permanent access roads, as well as some temporary access roads (collectively the "Work Areas"). Some of the existing access roads would be improved. Eversource can access each of the structure replacement locations utilizing its existing rights; but, it is currently working with private landowners to obtain rights to utilize alternative off-ROW access routes that would reduce the amount of proposed access roads that would need to be installed within the ROW and lessen the impacts to wetlands.
- b) Collectively, utilizing existing and proposed access roads where rights are in place, the Work Activities would result in approximately 359,029 square feet ("SF") of temporary wetland/watercourse impacts from the temporary use of matting required for the construction of access roads and work pads for 46 structures. See Table 1 for a summary of these temporary wetland impacts.
 - Work would be conducted in accordance with Eversource's *Best Management Practices Manual for Massachusetts and Connecticut (Construction and Maintenance Environmental Requirements)*, September 2016 ("BMPs") to avoid impacts to nearby wetland and watercourse resources.
- c) No direct impacts to vernal pools ("VP") would result from the proposed Work Activities. However, one Potential Vernal Pool ("PVP") habitat has been identified near some Work Areas. Portions of the existing access for Structures 6185 and 6187 would be located within the Potential Vernal Pool Envelope ("PVPE") associated with PVP1. The existing access is a well-established gravel driveway utilized by the owner to access their property and buildings beyond the ROW. The driveway intersects the ROW near PVPE1 and spans Spruce Brook and the associated wetland with the use of an existing bridge. The existing access road would not be widened or altered where it extends into the PVPE habitat. Elevated construction matting would be used for the temporary access for Structure 6185 to allow amphibian migration. Vegetation removal in the PVPE will be minimized and limited to hand clearing only. With the implementation of these protective measures, no adverse impact to the PVP or PVPE would result from the Work Activities.
- d) Based on review of the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection's ("CTDEEP") Natural Diversity Database ("NDDB"), only the Work Activities associated with the work pads for Structures 6-202, 6-230, 6-232 and 6-234 and the access for Structure 6-229 and the work pads and access for Structures 6156, 6155, 6148, 6-235 and 6-237, are proposed within a NDDB buffered area and wetland jurisdictional area and therefore would be subject to a NDDB review request. Eversource is currently in consultation with CTDEEP regarding Eversource's proposed work in these areas and will adhere to any state-listed species protection measures recommended by CTDEEP, as necessary. Any recommended

measures will be incorporated into Eversource's BMPs during construction. With these protective measures, no adverse impacts to state-listed rare species are anticipated.

- e) The Work Activities will not require any tree clearing. However, Eversource may need to undertake tree trimming and/or vegetation removal/mowing within the managed ROW corridor to improve access to portions of the Work Areas.
- f) A Phase 1A assessment review of previously recorded cultural resources on file with the Connecticut State Historic Preservation Office was conducted by Heritage Consultants, LLC ("Heritage). One National Register of Historic Places properties/districts and two State Register of Historic Places properties were identified within 500 feet of Work Areas. Based on existing conditions, distance from the Work Areas, the presence of intervening vegetation, the like-for-like design of the replacement structures, and the modest average height increase of 5 feet for structures in these Work Areas, none of the proposed Work Activities would directly impact the historic structures or substantially change views of the ROW from the historic structures.

Based on a review of historic maps, aerial photographs and available soil profiles the Work Areas were identified to possess a potential for no or low archaeological sensitivity; therefore, Heritage advised that no further examination is recommended or warranted.

- g) Increases in the heights of the 80 replacement structures will average approximately 6 feet. Structure 6141 would increase in height by approximately 14 feet.
- h) The majority of the replacement structures would be located within 15 feet of existing structures, except for Structures 6139 and 6-311, which would be located approximately 20 feet from the existing locations.
- i) Work Activities associated with Structures 6187 and 6185 are located partially or entirely within the mapped 100-year flood zone associated with Spruce Brook. Work Activities associated with Structures 6-222 and 6-324 are located partially within the mapped 100-year flood zone associated with East Swamp Brook. Work Activities associated with Structures 6-228, 6-234 and 6-237 are located partially within the mapped 100-year flood zone associated with the Coginchaug River. Work Activities associated with Structures 6-234 and 6-235 are located partially within the floodway associated with the Coginchaug River. Eversource would utilize its BMPs to minimize any impacts to the flood zones and floodway by utilizing temporary construction matting and/or by not placing fill that would increase the elevations of the existing or proposed road surfaces or work pads to ensure that the floodplain and floodway hydrology would not be adversely affected. With these protective measures and the use of the BMPs, no adverse impact to the 100-year flood zones and floodway would result from the proposed Work Activities.
- j) No change in noise levels would result from the installation of the new structures and the applicable lines would continue to comply with the State of Connecticut noise regulations.
- k) Any changes in electric and magnetic field levels outside the ROW would be negligible.

IV. Mitigation:

Temporary environmental effects from construction will be mitigated as follows:

- Erosion and sediment controls ("E&S") will be employed and maintained, as needed, for the duration of the Work Activities in accordance with the 2002 Connecticut Guidelines for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control and the BMPs.
- Potential impacts to wetlands and watercourses will be mitigated with the use of temporary construction matting and adherence to the BMPs.
- Vernal pool protective measures will be incorporated into the Eversource BMPs during construction.
- Any NDDB recommended rare species protective measures will be incorporated into Eversource's BMPs during construction.
- Potential impacts to the 100-year flood zones and the floodway would be avoided with adherence to the BMPs and the use of temporary construction matting.
- Eversource's contractor will perform construction sequencing such that any earth materials are exposed for a minimum amount of time before they are covered, seeded, or otherwise stabilized to prevent erosion.
- During construction, when necessary, anti-tracking mats would be installed at construction entrances onto public roads to prevent tracking of soil onto local streets.
- Upon completion of the Work Activities, all disturbed/exposed areas would be stabilized and revegetated as needed. After the establishment of permanent ground cover, Eversource's contractor would remove the temporary E&S controls and remove/dispose of any accumulated sediments and debris from areas where such measures were used.

V. Access:

Some new permanent access roads would be constructed to facilitate access to structures on Eversource property and/or within the ROW and existing access roads in upland areas may be hardened and temporarily widened at turning areas to facilitate the safe passage of construction vehicles. Construction matting would be used for temporary access roads in wetlands, sensitive cultural areas, as well as in agricultural/maintained lawn upland areas. The matting will be removed upon completion of the Work Activities and the areas restored, as necessary.

Eversource would access the Work Areas by entering its property and/or the ROW from existing access points on public roads as follows:

Berlin

- Beckley Road for Structures 6188, 6187 and 6185
- Berlin Street for Structures 6183, 6180, 6179, 6178 and 6177
- Mill Street for Structures 6176 and 6175
- Ledge Road for Structure 6171
- Spruce Brook Road for Structure 6169

Middletown

- Spruce Brook Road for Structures 6165, 6163 and 6162
- Bradley Street for 6161, 6160 and 6159
- Timber Ridge Road for Structure 6158
- Middle Street for Structures 6156, 6155, 6152 and 6148 (off-ROW access from an alternative location on Middle Street would be used for Structures 6156 and 6155 if rights are obtained)
- Oak Ridge Lane for Structures 6-300, 6142, 6141 and 6140
- Country Club Road for Structures 6139, 6138, 6136, 6135, 6134 and 6133
- Sisk Street for Structures 6131, 6130, 6129, 6128, 6127 and 6126
- Higby Road for Structure 6123
- Oak Ridge Drive for Structures 6-202, 6-203, 6-204 and 6-304
- East Street for Structures 6-207, 6-209 and 6-309
- Poplar Road for Structures 6-210, 6-310 6-311, 6-312, 6-213, 6-214, 6-314 and 6-215 (off-ROW access from an alternative location on Poplar Road would be used for Structures 6-214 and 6-314 if rights are obtained)
- Ridgewood Road for Structure 6-216
- Azalea Drive for Structures 6-217, 6-218 and 6-219
- Cynthia Lane for Structures 6-220, 6-221, 6-321,6-222 and 6-324
- Newfield Street for Structures 6-225, 6-226 and 6-228
- Stony Crest Drive for Structures 6-229, 6-230 and 6-232
- Rose Circle for Structure 6-233
- Griffin Place for Structure 6-234, 6-235 and 6-237 (off-ROW access from Columbus Avenue would be used for Structures 6-235 and 6-237 if rights are obtained)
