The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy (Eversource) received approval from the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on March 26, 2020 (Sub-Petition No. 1293-BPKP-01). On December 30, 2021 Eversource was granted a one-year extension to complete the improvements associated with the above-referenced sub-petition by March 26, 2023. In its December 30, 2021 letter granting a one-year extension, the Council included conditions regarding the need for additional time to complete maintenance improvements on the above-referenced Sub-Petition based on the following condition:

• This extension is granted with the understanding that the Council will be notified should Eversource need additional time to complete maintenance improvements or decides not to proceed with construction.
