RE: SUB-PETITION NO. 1293 - BR-03 (Brookfield) – Eversource Energy declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for all transmission facility asset condition maintenance improvements statewide to comply with the updated National Electrical Safety Code clearance requirements. Request for Project Changes.

Dear Kathleen Shanley:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated December 29, 2023 regarding project changes to the Petition No. 1293 sub-petition for the above-referenced section of transmission line that was approved by the Council on November 1, 2022.

The proposed project changes include the modification of the work pad at Structure 10211 by adding 3,371 square feet of temporary matting and installing a temporary coffer dam and temporary swale around the structure work pad to create a safe work environment for construction vehicles and structure replacement activities.

Pursuant to the Council's March 31, 2017 Declaratory Ruling, and November 1, 2022 decision on this sub-petition, your request for the proposed project changes is hereby approved.

This approval applies only to the project changes in the correspondence dated December 29, 2023.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes §16-50u.

Re: SUB-PETITION NO. 1293–BR-03 (Brookfield): 321/1618 Transmission Line Structure Replacement Project (Town of Brookfield) – Minor Change Request

Dear Attorney Bachman:

On November 1, 2022, the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") ruled that the above referenced Sub-Petition notice would not have a substantial adverse environmental effect and would not require a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need. Condition 2 of the ruling indicates any project changes shall require the filing of a new notice with the Council. This notice presents the proposed minor changes.

After further review of the proposed work pad at Structure 10211 it was determined that the configuration would have presented a safety concern for large construction vehicles due to unstable soils and uneven terrain and that a modified work pad is needed to allow equipment, including a large crane, to safely traverse throughout the narrow work area while performing the structure replacement activities. Temporarily diverting the upgradient portion of watercourse S03 and eliminating the previously proposed matted span will allow for the installation of a more stable matted work pad.

The following minor changes are proposed to accommodate a safe work pad for structure replacement activities, as follows:

- Install additional matting within the adjacent shallow open water impoundment, east of
 the structure location. The additional matting will result in a temporary open water
 impact of approximately 3,371 square feet. The matting will be removed upon
 completion of the project and the work area restored to its original condition. See
 revised Map Sheet 1.
- Install a temporary cofferdam at the existing concrete spillway of the impoundment to block the outflow and construct a rip-rap diversion swale to temporarily divert waterflow of the existing intermittent watercourse, SO3, around the matted work area.

The diversion will result in a temporary intermittent stream impact of approximately 255 square feet. See revised Map Sheet 1 and attached Figure - Proposed Diversion Swale.

There will no permanent in-stream or wetland impact, and grading to level the matted work pad will occur in upland area only. The temporary diversion swale and cofferdam will be removed after installation of the replacement structure and the area restored to its original condition. Eversource has consulted with the US Army Corps of Engineers and will be utilizing the Self-Verification Notification Form to permit the activities described above.

The municipal officials of Brookfield and the abutters will be notified of the proposed minor project changes. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any questions regarding this request.




