Dear Attorney Bachman:

The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy (Eversource) received approval from the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on November 1, 2022 for Sub-Petition No. 1293-BR-03. In its November 1, 2022 letter acknowledging the above referenced Sub-Petition, the Council included conditions, regarding the need for additional time to complete maintenance activities on the above referenced Sub-Petition based on the following condition:

• The petitioner may file a request for an extension of time beyond the one year deadline provided that such request is submitted to the Council not less than 60 days prior to the expiration.

The project has experienced delays due to a number of factors and Eversource hereby requests that the deadline to complete these activities be extended to November 1, 2024.

Eversource recognizes that the standard time period to make such an extension request occur 60 days prior to the expiration and apologizes for not meeting this timeframe.
