The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy (Eversource) received approval from the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on June 5, 2018 (Petition No. 1293). On March 22, 2019 Eversource was granted a one-year extension to complete the improvements associated with the above-referenced sub-petition by June 5, 2020.
