Dear Attorney Bachman:

On September 30, 2019, the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") issued a ruling that the subject Project would not have an adverse environmental effect and would not require a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need.

Since the time of the Council's ruling, Eversource has identified five additional transmission structures on the 352 Line that require replacement due to asset condition. Eversource plans to conduct the transmission structure replacement work to remediate structure damage caused by age, weather, and woodpecker activity. In support of the additional structure replacements, the following work ("Work Activities") will be performed:

- Replace five existing wood H-Frame structures with new weathering steel H-Frame structures. With the exception of Structure 8113, which would change from a 2-Pole H-Frame design to a 3-Pole H-Frame design, to increase the phase-to-phase clearance requirements, the remainder of the structures will be replaced with the same H-Frame design. Two of the additional structures, 8113 and 8204, will be installed within 15 feet of the existing structure locations. Structure 8105 would be repositioned 70 feet from the existing structure to reduce impacts to a watercourse. Structure 8121 would be repositioned 20 feet from the existing structure to relocate it off a small rocky knoll, enabling a level work pad to be safely constructed for the structure replacement work and Structure 8185 would be repositioned 65 feet from the existing structure to move it away from an access road and an underground propane line associated with an existing commercial greenhouse operation. To comply with current conductor clearance requirements, Structures 8121, 8185 and 8204 will be raised in height by 13.5 feet and Structure 8113 will be raised in height by 4.5 feet. Structure 8105 would not require a height increase. Work Activities would take place in areas within Eversource's property and existing right-of-way ("ROW") utilizing existing and proposed new permanent access roads, as well as some temporary access roads (collectively the "Work Areas"). Some of the existing access roads will be improved. See revised Attachment A; "352 Line - Structure Replacement Project" "Sub-Petition Map Set", dated August 29, 2019, revised April 10, 2020.

Eversource respectfully submits that the proposed modifications would have no "substantial adverse environmental effect" pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-50k, based on the following factors;

Work Activities associated with the five additional replacement structures will result in approximately 5,015 square feet of temporary wetland impacts, limited to temporary construction matting required for the construction of the work pads for Structures 8105, 8185 and 8204 and the access for Structure 8113. There are no flood zones or vernal pools associated with the Work Areas.

Based on a review of the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection's ("CTDEEP") Natural Diversity Database ("NDDB"), no Work Areas are proposed within a NDDB buffered area and wetland jurisdictional area and/or CTDEEP owned/managed land; therefore, they would not be subject to a NDDB review request. Work would be conducted in accordance with Eversource's Best Management Practices to avoid or minimize impact to terrestrial habitats that may support rare species. With these protective measures, no adverse impacts to state-listed rare species are anticipated.

The Work Activities will not require any tree clearing. However, Eversource may need to undertake tree trimming and/or vegetation removal/mowing within the managed ROW corridor to improve access to the Work Areas.

A Phase IA assessment review of previously recorded cultural resources on file with the Connecticut State Historic Preservation Office conducted by Heritage Consultants, LLC ("Heritage") did not identify any National or State Register of Historic Places properties/districts located within 500 feet of the Work Areas. Based on a review of historic maps, aerial photographs, and available soil profiles, the proposed structure replacement locations were identified by Heritage as possessing no to low archaeological sensitivity. Therefore, no protective measures are required for the proposed activity and no further investigation is recommended or warranted.

No change in noise levels would result from the installation of the replacement structures and the applicable lines would continue to comply with the State of Connecticut noise regulations. Any changes in electric and magnetic field levels off the ROW would be negligible.

Three new permanent access roads would be constructed to facilitate access to two of the proposed additional structures. Existing access roads in upland areas associated with the proposed additional structures may be hardened and temporarily widened at turning areas to facilitate the safe passage of construction vehicles. Construction matting would be used as temporary access roads in wetlands. The matting will be removed upon completion of the Work Activities and the areas restored, as necessary.

Temporary environmental effects from construction will be mitigated using appropriate erosion and sediment controls ("E&S") in accordance with the 2002 *Connecticut Guidelines for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control* and Eversource's *Best Management Practices Manual for Massachusetts and Connecticut* (Construction and Maintenance Environmental Requirements), dated September 2016. Upon completion of the Work Activities, all disturbed/exposed areas would be stabilized and revegetated. After the establishment of permanent ground cover, Eversource's contractor would remove temporary E&S controls and remove/dispose of any accumulated sediments and debris from areas where such measures were used.

Prior to submitting this amendment Eversource representatives briefed officials in the towns of Roxbury, Woodbury and Watertown concerning the project modifications. In addition, Eversource provided abutters with written notice of the filing of the Amendment.

Eversource will access Work Areas using existing access roads within the right-of-way ("ROW") from existing access points on public roads as follows:

Roxbury

- Painter Ridge Road for Structure 8105
- Washington Woodbury Road for Structures 8113

Woodbury



4. THE CONTRACTOR WILL ENSURE THAT THE TRAIL REMAINS OPEN AND PASSABLE TO ALL USERS; AND
5. THE CONTRACTOR WILL TAKE ALL NECESSARY MEASURES TO ENSURE THAT THE TRAIL IS NOT DAMAGED, AND IS RETURNED TO ITS ORIGINAL CONDITION PRIOR TO THE START OF THE ACTIVITY (E.G., RESTORES ANY RUTTING CAUSED BY MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT OR OTHER EQUIPMENT).
