Structure Locations: Four Transmission Line Structures located in Ridgefield, Connecticut

I. Introduction:

In accordance with Condition 1 of the March 30, 2017 ruling by the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council") (as set forth in the Council's March 31, 2017 letter) regarding Petition No. 1293, The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy ("Eversource") submits this Sub-Petition.

II. <u>Description of Transmission Work Activities:</u>

Eversource's 1470/1565 Transmission Line Structure Replacement Project ("Project") is part of an ongoing maintenance program which evaluates the integrity of its utility structures and implements repair, upgrade or replacement in order to ensure the safe and reliable transmission of power to its customers. Due to asset condition, four structures on the 1470/1565 Lines require replacement; the structures are located on either side of Florida Road in Ridgefield, Connecticut. The 1470 Line, in its entirety, is a 115-killovolt ("kV") line that extends from Eversource's existing Wilton Substation in Wilton to Peaceable Substation in Redding to Ridgefield Substation in Ridgefield. The 115-kV 1565 Line, which in the Project area is collocated within the same right-of-way ("ROW") as the 1470 Line, extends between the Plumtree Substation in Bethel to Peaceable and Ridgefield substations. Compared to the existing structures, the four replacement structures will require an increase in height to comply with current clearance requirements.

Eversource plans to conduct transmission structure replacement work to remediate damage caused by structure age, cracks, weather, and woodpecker activity. The following work ("Work Activities") will be performed:

 Replace two existing wood pole structures on the 1470 Line (Structures 3281 and 3281B) and two existing wood pole structures on the 1565 Line (Structures 3281C and 3281D) with weathering steel structures. Each replacement structure will be of the same design as its corresponding existing structure, though slightly taller.

III. No Substantial Adverse Environmental Effect:

Eversource respectfully submits that the proposed modifications would have no "substantial adverse environmental effect" pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-50k, based on the following factors:

- a) All Work Activities would take place on Eversource's property or within its existing ROW, utilizing direct access from Florida Road to the temporary construction mat work pad for Structures 3281B and 3281D and an existing permanent access road (which will be improved) to reach the temporary construction mat work pad for Structures 3181 and 3281C (collectively the "Work Areas"). Eversource will access each of the structure replacement locations using its existing rights.
- b) The Work Activities would not result in any impacts to wetlands or watercourses. No wetlands are located in or near the Work Areas; only one stream is located nearby. Work would be conducted in accordance with Eversource's *Best Management Practices Manual for Massachusetts and Connecticut (Construction and Maintenance Environmental Requirements)*, September 2016 ("BMPs") to avoid impacts to the nearby watercourse.
- c) No vernal pools or vernal pool envelopes are located in proximity to the proposed Work Areas.
- d) Based on review of the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection's ("CTDEEP's") Natural Diversity Database ("NDDB"), no Work Areas are proposed within a NDDB buffered area and wetland jurisdictional area and/or CTDEEP owned/managed land. Therefore, the Work Areas would not be subject to a NDDB Review Request. Work would be conducted in accordance with Eversource's BMPs to avoid or minimize impact to terrestrial habitats that may support rare species. With these protective measures, no adverse impacts to state-listed rare species are anticipated.
- e) The Work Activities will not require any tree clearing. However, Eversource may need to undertake tree trimming and/or vegetation removal/mowing within the managed ROW corridor for conductor clearance and/or to improve access to portions of the Work Areas.
- f) A Phase 1A assessment review of previously recorded cultural resources on file with the Connecticut State Historic Preservation Office conducted by Heritage Consultants, LLC ("Heritage") did not identify any National or State Register of Historic Places properties/districts or archeological sites within 500 feet of the Work Areas. Based on the results of the Phase 1A, Heritage advised that no further examination is recommended or warranted.
- g) The Work Areas are within a portion of the Ridgefield Rail Trail ("Trail"), which extends along a former railroad corridor. The Trail, which is listed as a Town of Ridgefield recreational resource, was repurposed and is owned by Eversource. The portion of the Trail affected by Work Activities will be closed during construction. Eversource has coordinated with and will provide advance notice of the Trail closure to the town. During the closure period, signs will be posted to alert any persons approaching the affected area from either direction along the Trail of its closure. After the completion of the structure replacements, the affected areas of the Trail will be restored to pre-construction conditions.
- h) Because the Work Activities are within the former railroad corridor, excavated soils will be managed and appropriately disposed of off-site based on the results of soil testing.
- i) To comply with current clearance requirements, Structure 3281B will increase in height by 12 feet, while the other three replacement structures will increase in height by less than 10 feet.

- j) The replacement structures are located on Eversource property along Florida Road, a town-designated scenic road. Florida Road will be used to access the Work Areas for all four structure replacements. The replacement structures will be of the same design and of similar appearance as the existing structures, which were installed in 1975, and thus will not adversely affect the visual character of the road.
- k) No impacts to local traffic are anticipated. Eversource will coordinate with the Town of Ridgefield regarding traffic controls to be implemented during construction.
- I) There are no 100-year flood zones in the Work Areas.
- m) No change in noise levels would result from the installation of the new structures and the applicable lines would continue to comply with the State of Connecticut noise regulations.
- n) Any changes in electric and magnetic field levels outside the ROW would be negligible.

IV. Mitigation:

Temporary environmental effects from construction will be mitigated as follows:

- Erosion and sediment controls ("E&S") will be employed and maintained, as needed, for the duration of the Work Activities in accordance with the 2002 Connecticut Guidelines for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control and the BMPs.
- Eversource's contractor will perform construction sequencing such that any earth materials
 are exposed for a minimum amount of time before they are covered, seeded, or otherwise
 stabilized to prevent erosion.
- During construction, when necessary, anti-tracking mats would be installed at construction entrances to public roads to prevent tracking of soil onto local roads.
- Upon completion of the Work Activities, all disturbed/exposed areas will be stabilized and revegetated as needed. After establishing permanent ground cover, Eversource's contractor would remove the temporary E&S controls and remove/dispose of any accumulated sediments and debris from areas where such measures were used.

V. Access:

Eversource will reach the Work Areas by entering and exiting the ROW from existing access points on Florida Road. One permanent access road would be improved to facilitate access to the Structures 3281 and 3281C within the ROW. Temporary construction matting will be used for Project work pads. The matting will be removed upon completion of the Work Activities and the areas restored.






