Dear Attorney Bachman:

The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) received approval from the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) on May 24, 2021 for Sub-Petition No. 1293-SBM-01. On March 10, 2022 Eversource was granted a one-year extension to complete the transmission line maintenance activities associated with the above-referenced Sub-Petition by May 24, 2023. In its May 24, 2021 letter acknowledging the above referenced Sub-Petition, the Council included conditions, regarding the need for additional time to complete maintenance activities on the above-referenced Sub-Petition based on the following condition:

- The petitioner may file a request for an extension of time beyond the one-year deadline provided that such request is submitted to the Council not less than 60 days prior to the expiration.

The project has experienced delays due to a number of factors and Eversource hereby requests that the deadline to complete these activities be extended to May 24, 2024.
