Dear Attorney Bachman:

The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy ("Eversource") received approval from the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on May 24, 2021 for Sub-Petition No. 1293-SBM-01. On March 27, 2023 the Council granted Eversource a one-year extension to complete the transmission line maintenance activities associated with the above-referenced Sub-Petition by May 24, 2024. In its March 27, 2023 letter granting an extension, the Council also indicated it be notified should Eversource need additional time to complete the maintenance improvements.

The project has experienced delays due to a number of factors and Eversource hereby requests that the deadline to complete these activities be extended to May 24, 2025.
