
The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) received approval from the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) on June 2, 2020 (Petition No. 1293). On April 5, 2021 Eversource was granted a one-year extension to complete the improvements associated with the above-referenced sub-petition by June 2, 2022. Eversource is requesting an extension of the deadline for completing the work activities based on the following condition:
