Request for Extension

Dear Attorney Bachman:

The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy (Eversource) received project approval from the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on June 2, 2020 (Sub-Petition No. 1293-SBMM-01). On March 31, 2023 Eversource was granted a third one-year extension to complete the improvements associated with the above-referenced sub-petition by June 2, 2024.

In its March 31, 2023 letter granting a one-year extension, the Council included conditions regarding the need for additional time to complete maintenance improvements on the above-referenced Sub-Petition based on the following condition:

• This extension is granted with the understanding that the Council will be notified should Eversource need additional time to complete maintenance improvements or decides not to proceed with construction.

The project has experienced delays due to several factors and Eversource hereby requests that the deadline to complete these activities be further extended to June 2, 2025.
