Structure Locations: 21 Transmission Line Structures in Southington, Berlin and Meriden, Connecticut

### I. Introduction:

In accordance with Condition 1 of the March 30, 2017 ruling by the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council") (as set forth in the Council's March 31, 2017 letter) regarding Petition No. 1293, The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy ("Eversource") submits this Sub-Petition.

### II. Description of Transmission Work Activities:

Eversource's 3754/3041 Transmission Lines Structure Replacement Project is part of an ongoing maintenance program which evaluates the integrity of its utility structures and implements repair, upgrade or replacement in order to ensure the safe and reliable transmission of power to its customers. Due to asset condition, 21 structures require replacement on the 3754/3041 Lines between a location just east of Southington Substation in Southington and Mayflower Lane in Meriden. The 3754 Line in its entirety, is a 345-kilovolt line that extends from Southington Substation to Beseck Substation in Wallingford. The 3041 Line in its entirety, is a 345-kilovolt line that extends from Southington Substation to Scovill Rock Substation in Middletown. The structures to be replaced are a mix of wood H-frame structures and wood three-pole structures. Twenty of the twenty-one replacement structures will require an increase in structure height to comply with current clearance requirements. Structure 9552 does not require an increase in structure height; however, the structure design is changing from a wood H-frame structure to a weathering steel three-pole structure.

Eversource plans to conduct transmission structure replacement work to remediate damage caused by structure age, weather, and woodpecker activity. The following work ("Work Activities") will be performed:

- Replace ten existing single-circuit wood H-frame structures (3754 Line) with ten single-circuit weathering steel H-frame structures.
- Replace six existing single-circuit wood H-frame structures (3041 Line) with six single-circuit weathering steel H-frame structures.

- Replace two existing single-circuit wood three-pole structures (3041 Line) with two single-circuit weathering steel three-pole structures.
- Replace one existing single-circuit wood H-frame structure (3754 Line) with one single-circuit weathering steel three-pole structure.
- Replace two existing single-circuit wood H-frame structures (3041 Line) with two single-circuit weathering steel three-pole structures.

### III. No Substantial Adverse Environmental Effect:

Eversource respectfully submits that the proposed modifications would have no "substantial adverse environmental effect" pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-50k, based on the following factors:

- All Work Activities would take place in areas within Eversource's property and existing right-of-way ("ROW") utilizing existing access roads, as well as some temporary access roads (collectively the "Work Areas"). Some of the existing access roads would be improved. Eversource can access each of the structure replacement locations utilizing its existing rights.
- b) Collectively, utilizing existing and temporary access roads, the Work Activities would result in approximately 21,377 square feet ("SF") of temporary wetland impacts from the temporary use of matting required for the construction of access roads and work pads for four structures as follows:

Work would be conducted in accordance with Eversource's *Best Management Practices Manual for Massachusetts and Connecticut (Construction and Maintenance Environmental Requirements),* September 2016 ("BMPs") to avoid impacts to nearby wetland and watercourse resources.

- c) No vernal pools or vernal pool envelopes are located in proximity to the proposed Work Areas.
- d) Based on review of the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection's ("CTDEEP") Natural Diversity Database ("NDDB"), the Work Activities associated with the work pads for Structures 9501 and 9554 are proposed within a NDDB polygon area and wetland jurisdictional area and therefore would be subject to a NDDB review request. Eversource is currently in consultation with CTDEEP regarding Eversource's proposed work in these areas and will adhere to any state-listed species protection measures recommended by CTDEEP, as necessary. Any recommended measures will be incorporated into Eversource's BMPs during construction. With these protective measures, no adverse impacts to state-listed rare species are anticipated.
- e) The Work Activities will not require any tree clearing. However, Eversource may need to undertake tree trimming and/or vegetation removal/mowing to establish required conductor clearance, to improve access roads and/or to install work pads within the Work Areas.

- f) A Phase 1A assessment review of previously recorded cultural resources on file with the Connecticut State Historic Preservation Office conducted by Heritage Consultants, LLC ("Heritage") did not identify any National or State Register of Historic Places properties/districts or archeological sites within 500 feet of the Work Areas. Based on a review of historic maps, aerial photographs, and available soil profiles, one proposed work pad location was identified to possess a potential for moderate to high archaeological sensitivity. Timber matting will be utilized at this location to avoid any soil disturbance. With this proposed mitigation, Heritage advised that no further examination is recommended or warranted.
- g) The average height increases of the 20 replacement structures increasing in height would be 7 feet to comply with clearance requirements. The heights of the existing structures range from 61 to 97 feet above ground level. The replacement structures will range in height from 70 to 101.5 feet above ground level. One structure, 9552, would not increase in height. Seventeen of the replacement structures would increase 10 feet or less. Structure 8715 would increase by 18 feet for an overall height of 83.5 feet above ground level. Structure 8677 would increase 13.5 feet for an overall height of 88 feet above ground level and Structure 8676 would increase 13.5 feet for an overall height of 74.5 feet above ground level.
- h) Twenty of the replacement structures would be installed within 15 feet or less of the existing structure locations. Structure 8715 would be repositioned 55 feet from the existing structure to relocate it off a rocky knoll, enabling a level work pad to be constructed to facilitate the safe replacement of the structure. The new structure location will be located on the same parcel as the existing structure location.
- i) There are no 100-year flood zones in the Work Areas.
- j) No change in noise levels would result from the installation of the new structures and the applicable line would continue to comply with the State of Connecticut noise regulations.
- k) Any changes in electric and magnetic field levels outside the ROW would be negligible.

### IV. <u>Mitigation:</u>

Temporary environmental effects from construction will be mitigated as follows:

- Erosion and sediment ("E&S") controls will be employed and maintained, as needed, for the duration of the Work Activities in accordance with the 2002 Connecticut Guidelines for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control and the BMPs.
- Potential impacts to wetlands will be mitigated with the use of temporary matting and adherence to the BMPs.
- Any NDDB recommendations regarding state-listed species protective measures will be incorporated into Eversource's BMPs during construction.
- Eversource's contractor will perform construction sequencing such that any earth materials are exposed for a minimum amount of time before they are covered, seeded, or otherwise stabilized to prevent erosion.
- During construction, when necessary, anti-tracking mats would be installed at construction entrances to public roads to prevent tracking of soil onto local roads.

• Upon completion of the Work Activities, all disturbed/exposed areas will be stabilized and revegetated as needed. After establishing permanent ground cover, Eversource's contractor would remove the temporary E&S controls and remove/dispose of any accumulated sediments and debris from areas where such measures were used.

### V. <u>Access:</u>

One temporary access road would be constructed in an upland area within the ROW to facilitate access to Structure 8677. This area will be restored following construction. Existing access roads in upland areas may be hardened and widened at turning areas to facilitate the safe passage of construction vehicles. Construction matting will be used for temporary access roads within wetlands, as well as in maintained lawn and agricultural upland areas. The matting will be removed upon completion of the Work Activities and the areas restored, as necessary.

Eversource will access the Work Areas by entering its ROW from existing access points on public roads as follows:

- Partridge Drive for Structure 8654

- Heritage Drive for Structures 8676 and 8677
- Summit Wood Drive for Structures 8679, 8681, 8682 and 9531

- North Colony Road for Structure 9540
- Westfield Road for Structures 8705, 9550, 9552, 8709 and 9554
- Mayflower Lane for Structure 8715






**TYPICAL CROSS SECTIONS** 














