Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-62 (b) and in response to your email correspondence dated October 13, 2021, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) staff hereby approves a temporary change to Partial Development and Management Plan I (Partial D&M Plan I) to allow for extended work hours in the vicinity of Canterbury Switching Station (Eversource Switchyard) from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 17, 2021 and Sunday, October 24, 2021.
