The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your email correspondence of April 23, 2020 regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced declaratory ruling issued by the Council on July 20, 2018.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Decision of July 20, 2018, your request to perform work from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, April 26, 2020 and Sunday, May 10, 2020 and from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Friday, May 8, 2020 and Saturday, May 9, 2020 is hereby approved.

Due to a prior incident that occurred within the substation and recent inclement weather, additional work hours are necessary to complete work during the scheduled outages on Line #3642 and Line #310. Such work must be completed by May 10, 2020 to facilitate other upcoming work at Millstone.

This approval applies only to the request for extended work hours in your email of April 23, 2020. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.

Subject: Manchester Substation - Request for Sunday and Extended Hours

Dear Ms. Bachman:

Eversource Energy is requesting Connecticut Siting Council staff review and approval for Sunday work hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. at Manchester Substation for the above-referenced project on April 26th and May 10th and for extended work hours from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Friday, May 8th and Saturday, May 9th. The Council previously approved work on Sunday, May 3rd. The extended hours are needed to complete work during the scheduled outages on Line 3642 and Line 310 that must be completed by May 10th to facilitate other upcoming work at Millstone. As the Council is aware the Project work has been recently interrupted by a safety incident. The Company's response to this incident delayed the Project work longer than anticipated and, in combination with a further delay caused by inclement weather experienced this week, the additional work hours requested are required to keep to the current outage schedule.

All work involved will take place within the existing substation yard and the relay and control enclosure buildings. We have notified the Town of Manchester of our intention to submit this request to the Council and the Town has no objection to these extended work hours.
