RE: **PETITION NO. 1347A** – GRE GACRUX LLC petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a 16.78-megawatt AC solar photovoltaic electric generating facility located at 117 Oil Mill Road and associated electrical interconnection to Eversource Energy's existing substation at 325 Waterford Parkway North in Waterford, Connecticut. Reopening of this petition based on changed conditions pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-181a(b).

Dear Ms. Moshier-Dunn:

With regard to the above-referenced matter, page 4 of GRE Gacrux, LLC's (GRE) March 9, 2020 brief on its February 26, 2020 request that Save the River, Save the Hills (STR-STH) retain legal counsel states, "... unlike Attorney McDermott, who is licensed and therefore authorized to practice law in this state, Ms. Moshier-Dunn is not. And while Ms. Moshier-Dunn is free to practice law for herself *pro se*, the authorization to appear *pro se* is limited to representing one's own cause, and does not permit individuals to appear *pro se* in a representative capacity for a corporation such as STR-STH."

In light of this statement in GRE's March 9, 2020 brief, please respond to the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) and the service list for the above-referenced matter in writing **on or before March 19, 2020** as to whether or not you wish to submit a request for intervenor status under your own name and if so, whether or not you wish to adopt the STR-STH submissions in this matter to date as your own.
