Construction Completion Letter

Dear Ms. Bachman:

On October 25, 2019, Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) received a declaratory ruling from the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) that a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need would not be required for the work proposed in Petition No. 1382 (“Petition”), subject to conditions. Among other conditions of the ruling, the Council required that Eversource submit the following item:

- Within 45 days after completion of construction, the Council shall be notified in writing that the construction has been completed.

The construction was completed on August 14, 2020. Eversource apologizes for the lateness of this notice.

Further, information in Eversource’s Petition for this project indicated that FAA lights would be installed on Structures 3658 and 3659. To address landowner complaints about this lighting, Eversource reached out to the FAA to seek a resolution and undertook further evaluation of the lighting. Upon this requested further evaluation, the FAA has agreed that the lights on these two structures are no longer necessary.
