The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated June 19, 2020 requesting a change in the frequency of submission of construction progress reports related to the Development and Management (D&M) Plan for the above-referenced project for which a partial D&M Plan was approved by the Council on May 26, 2020.

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-62(b), effective immediately, your request for a change in the frequency of submission of construction progress reports from monthly to quarterly is hereby approved.

This approval applies only to the D&M Plan revision dated June 19, 2020. Any significant changes to the D&M Plan require advance Council notification and approval.
