4. The electrical trenching for the Project.

In Progress


1. Installation of the Project’s electrical wiring;
2. Installation of the Project’s electrical switchgear; and,
3. Installation of the perimeter chain-link fencing.

Given the progress that has been achieved at the site to date, Cobb Road anticipates that Project construction will be completed by the end of September 2021.
