## Final Report

- 1. The project was constructed in accordance with, and in line with, the drawings and documents previously submitted to the Siting Council. No significant changes were made to the project's design since the project was approved by the Council, and the project was constructed in accordance with those designs.
- 2. There were no significant changes during the construction of the project from the approved D&M Plan.
- 3. There were no significant changes between the drawings submitted and approved by the Council as part of the Petition 1385 filings and the completed as-built site drawings.
- 4. There are no agreements with abutters or other property owners regarding special maintenance precautions.
- 5. In order to not burden the Council with a request for a protective order, cost data is not included in this report. If the Siting Council requires such data, the Petitioner will seek to file such information in a separate filing under seal.
- 6. There are no permanent civil structures present at the solar site. Only posts and racking to support the solar panels, along with inverters, fencing, and pad-mounted interconnection equipment is present at the site.
- 7. As the Council has been previously informed, all equipment for the project has been installed and is operational as of September 22, 2021.
