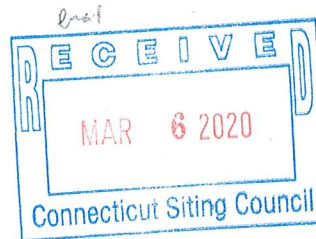

**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO
RESPOND TO COUNCIL INTERROGATORIES**

Doosan Fuel Cell America, Inc. ("Doosan") hereby moves the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") for an extension of time to respond to the Council's Interrogatory #11 issued February 27, 2020, in the above-captioned matter. In support of this Motion, Doosan states:

1. Doosan received the Interrogatories via electronic mail on February 27, 2020. The deadline to respond to Interrogatories is March 12, 2020. Interrogatory #11 asked "Considering the location of the fuel cell in relation to the residence and school, would any noise mitigation measures be required to comply with DEEP Noise Control Standards?"
2. Subsequent to these interrogatories' comments from the Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) were provided to Doosan related to the noise from the proposed installation. The CEQ comments requested that Doosan should undertake a noise study to determine the impacts and sound abatement measures.
3. Doosan has contracted with an acoustical consultant to perform a noise study of the proposed project.
4. Doosan requires additional time in order to conduct a full sound analysis for the site, and to more fully assess and gather information and data needed to fully answer Interrogatory #11 and address the concerns raised in the CEQ comments.

WHEREFORE, for all of the foregoing reasons, Doosan hereby requests that the Council grant an extension of time to respond to the Interrogatory No. 11 until April 1, 2020.
