7. Referencing Partial D&M Plan II Overall Site Electrical Plan PV-3, an overhead interconnection line is shown along the site access drive, supported by 5 new utility poles. The initial approved D&M site plan showed an underground interconnection line from both System 1 and System 2 to a respective riser pole adjacent to Benz Street.
 - a) What is the reason for the change in the interconnection design?
 - b) What is the purpose of the three “New Riser Poles”?
 - c) Can the span lengths be increased to reduce the number of poles?
 - d) Can the underground line be extended to reduce the number of poles?
