**PETITION NO. 1399** – Iroquois Gas Transmission System, L.P. petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and 16-50k, that modifications to its existing natural gas compressor stations located in the Towns of Brookfield and Milford, Connecticut ("Enhancement by Compression Project") are under the exclusive jurisdiction of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and 16-50k, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of a petition for a declaratory ruling from Iroquois Gas Transmission System, L.P. that modifications to its existing natural gas compressor station in the City of Milford are under the exclusive jurisdiction of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.
