RE: **PETITION NO. 1405** - The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed Horton Cove Circuit Separation Project consisting of a partial rebuild and separation of approximately 1 mile of its existing No. 100 69-kilovolt (kV) and Nos. 1410, 1280, and 1355 115-kV electric transmission line structures within existing Eversource electric transmission line right-of-way between a location east of Depot Road to a point east of Point Breeze Road, Montville, Connecticut, and related electric transmission line structure improvements.
