NuPower Bridgeport FC, LLC Motion for Party Status

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes (Conn. Gen. Stat.) §§ 4-177a and 16-50n and Section 16-50j-14 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies ("R.C.S.A."), NuPower Bridgeport FC, LLC ("NuPower" or the "Company") hereby requests that the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council" or "CSC") grant NuPower party status in the above-captioned proceeding. The Company represents that its legal rights, duties or privileges will be specifically affected by the Council's decision in this matter. In support of this motion, NuPower states as follows:

1. On May 11, 2020 Doosan Fuel Cell America, Inc. ("Doosan") filed a petition for a declaratory ruling as agent for and on behalf of NuPower with the Council. In the petition, Doosan requested that the Council approve the location and construction of twenty-one (21) natural gas fueled fuel cells and associated equipment to be located at 600 Iranistan Avenue in Bridgeport (the "Facility"). The fuel cells will provide 9.66 megawatts ("MW") of power to The United Illuminating Company's Congress Street

substation. The Facility will be installed by Doosan and will be owned and operated by

NuPower.

2.

As the owner of the proposed Facility, NuPower requests the right to

participate as a party in this proceeding. NuPower does not intend to cross-examine

witnesses. However, NuPower may provide pre-filed testimony and will be available to

answer any questions about the Facility the Council may have during the course of the

proceeding, including at a Council hearing if one is held. Additionally, NuPower may

wish to file written comments or a brief on issues affecting its interests. As the owner of

the Facility, NuPower will be specifically affected by the Council's decision on the

Facility.

3. Conn. Gen. Stat. § 4-177a authorized the Council to grant party status in a

contested case if a person submits a written petition, stating "facts that demonstrate that

the petitioner's legal rights, duties or privileges shall be specifically affected by the

agency's decision." For the reasons explained above, NuPower respectfully submits

that its participation as a party in this proceeding satisfies the criteria in Conn. Gen.

Stat. §§4-177a and 16-50n and R.C.S.A §16-50j-14.
