We as the council members for 131st district are writing this letter to support our residents and constituents of the Bridgeport's South End. The residents are in opposition of the fuel cell plant being place at 600 Iranistan Ave.

One concern is that the facility is very close to the railroad tracks and I-95. Another is that the plant will emit greenhouse gases in an area already subject to high levels of ground-level ozone. Further, the site is at the entrance way to Seaside Village, Seaside Park, the new Windward housing complex, as well as one entrance way to The University of Bridgeport.
