On behalf of New Cingular Wireless PCS LLC ("AT&T"), we respectfully submit this letter in connection with the above referenced Petition approved by the Siting Council on August 14, 2020.

AT&T recently advised that the small cell facility approved in the above-referenced petition is no longer viable. In order to provide the service needed by the small cell facility, AT&T searched for a new site and located an existing utility pole in the public right of way that can accommodate its small cell facility. Given that PURA has jurisdiction over this new location, AT&T will seek PURA approval for its proposed small cell facility at the new location and advises the Siting Council that it will not construct the facility approved in Petition 1413.
