RE: Petition No. 1419 - Bloom Energy Corporation petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a customer-side 150-kilowatt fuel cell facility and associated equipment to be located at The Home Depot, 114 Federal Road, Danbury, Connecticut

Dear Attorney Bachman:

On September 10, 2020, the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) approved by declaratory ruling a proposed Bloom Energy Corporation (“Bloom”) fuel cell facility (the “Facility”) at The Home Depot located at 114 Federal Road, Danbury, CT (the “Site”). On February 23, 2021, Bloom requested a minor modification to the location of the Facility on the Site in order to avoid a utility easement that conflicted with the approved location. The Council approved the modification by letter dated February 24, 2021.

Since that time, Bloom has obtained permission from the easement holder to install and operate the Facility in the originally proposed location. Accordingly, Bloom requests approval of a return to the location approved in the Council’s ruling on September 10, 2020. There will be no changes to the plans and details presented in Petition No. 1419.
