RE: **PETITION NO. 1419** - Bloom Energy Corporation declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a customer-side 150-kilowatt fuel cell facility and associated equipment to be located at the Home Depot, 114 Federal Road, Danbury, Connecticut.

Dear Mr. Adams:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated February 23, 2021 regarding project changes for the above-referenced declaratory ruling issued by the Council on September 11, 2020.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling on September 11, 2020, the request to shift the location and orientation of the fuel cell facility 10 feet to the north due to an existing utility easement that conflicts with the originally approved location is hereby approved.

The revised location of the fuel cell facility and reorientation of the equipment would not impact the drive aisle. Noise associated with the modified fuel cell facility location would comply with the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection Noise Control Regulations. The locations of accessory equipment and the interconnection will remain as approved.

This approval applies only to the project changes in the correspondence dated February 23, 2021. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.
