I am writing to you on behalf of our client, Southington Solar One, LLC ("Southington Solar One"), in connection with the above-referenced Petition. By correspondence dated July 28, 2021, the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council") informed Southington Solar One that, construction of the project can now commence. Accordingly, please allow this letter to serve as notification to the Council that the project will commence construction on or about Monday, August 9, 2021. Attached for your review is the Notice of Permit Authorization (Application No. 202007983) that Southington Solar One received from the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection ("CTDEEP") on August 4, 2021.

In addition, this letter will serve as a formal request to the Council regarding the project's reporting requirements under § 16-50j-62 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies ("RCSA"). Pursuant to RCSA § 16-50j-62(b)(3), Southington Solar One is presently required to provide the Council with monthly construction progress reports for the project. Southington Solar One respectfully requests that the Council modify the reporting time intervals for the project from monthly to quarterly, as the Council is authorized to do under RCSA § 16-50j-62(b)(3).
