The Connecticut Sitting Council has requested in their Development and Management Plan request for the subject project that we reach out to Dam Safety regarding permit requirements if any for the project.

It is our understanding that "Any dam which impounds less than three acre-feet of water (when assuming the water level at the crest of the dam) will not require a Dam Safety Construction Permit."

For this project at the crest of the proposed basin, elevation 193.5, the storage is at that elevation is 2.27 acre-feet. Thus it is our understanding that the project would not require a Dam Safety Permit.
