# NOTICE OF SUNJET ENERGY, LLC'S ELECTION TO WAIVE EXCLUSION OF ITS PROPOSED FACLITY FROM SITING COUNCIL JURISDICTION

SunJet Energy, LLC ("SunJet" or the "Company") is developing a solar photovoltaic facility with a nameplate capacity of up to 1.0 MW AC ("Project" or "Facility"). The proposed Project has entered into a zero emissions renewable energy credit ("ZREC") agreement with The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy ("Eversource"). The Project will be located at 0 Matthews Street and be interconnected on an adjacent parcel at 125 Hill Street in Bristol, Connecticut. Because the Project (1) will have a nameplate capacity of only up to 1 MW AC and (2) has entered into a ZREC agreement with Eversource Energy, the Project is likely excluded from the Connecticut Siting Council's ("Council") jurisdiction.

However, Conn. Gen. Stat.§ 16-50k(e) allows any person intending to construct the type of facility being developed by SunJet to elect to waive the facility's exclusion from Council jurisdiction by providing notice to the Council that the person will submit the facility to the jurisdiction of the Council. Conn. Gen. Stat.§ 16-50k(e) provides:

Any person intending to construct a facility excluded from one or more provision of this chapter may, to the extent permitted by law, elect to waive such exclusion by delivering notice of such waiver to the council. Such provisions shall thereafter apply to each facility identified in such notice from the date of its receipt with the council. [Emphasis Added.]

In accordance with Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-50k(e), SunJet hereby provides notice to the Council regarding the Company's election to waive any exclusions of the Project from the Council's

jurisdiction and submits the Project to the full jurisdiction of the Council.

Concurrent with this notice, SunJet is submitting a petition for declaratory ruling ("Petition") regarding the proposed Project to the Council.
