Dear Senator Slap:

Pursuant to section 16-50j-40(a) of the regulations of the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council"), we are notifying you that Burlington Solar One, LLC filed a petition for declaratory ruling with the Council on November 3, 2020 (Petition No. 1437). This petition requests the Council's approval of the location and construction of a 3.5 megawatt alternating current ground-mounted solar photovoltaic system on an approximately 63-acre parcel of land in the Town of Burlington, Connecticut ("the Project"). The project will utilize roughly 25 acres of the parcel.

The Project is located in the south central to southeastern portion of Burlington, on a parcel located at Prospect Street, across the street from 81 Prospect Street. The parcel is vacant land and currently has no street address. The parcel is on the north side of Prospect Street, just northeast of Prospect Street's intersection with South Main Street.

The Project consists of solar modules, string inverters, driven post racking, DC string wiring, AC wire runs, transformers, switchgear, metering equipment, security fencing and access roads. The Project will be interconnected with Eversource's electric distribution system.
