Dear Attorney Baldwin and Attorney Schaefer:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated February 14, 2024, regarding a revision to the Partial Development and Management (D&M) Plan III approval issued by the Council on December 8, 2023 for the above-referenced facility.

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA) §16-50j-62(b), your request to modify Wet Swale No. 11 by relocating the emergency outfall structure to discharge to the east rather than the south is hereby approved.

This approval applies only to the Partial D&M Plan III revision dated February 14, 2024.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling and approved D&M Plan are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Furthermore, the facility owner/operator is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to RCSA §16-50j-62.

Swale 11 Minor Modification

Dear Attorney Bachman:

In accordance with RCSA § 16-50j-62(b), SR Litchfield, LLC (“SRL”) hereby notifies the Connecticut Siting Council’s (“Council”) of a minor modification to the approved stormwater design. At the request of Ron Viola, a neighboring property owner, SRL has redesigned Swale 11 to modify the location of the emergency spillway. This modification requires a minor expansion of the limits of disturbance to the east of Swale 11 by 456 square feet (0.01 acre). The Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) Stormwater Bureau has reviewed and accepted this minor modification to Swale 11 and has incorporated the same into the existing Stormwater General Permit.

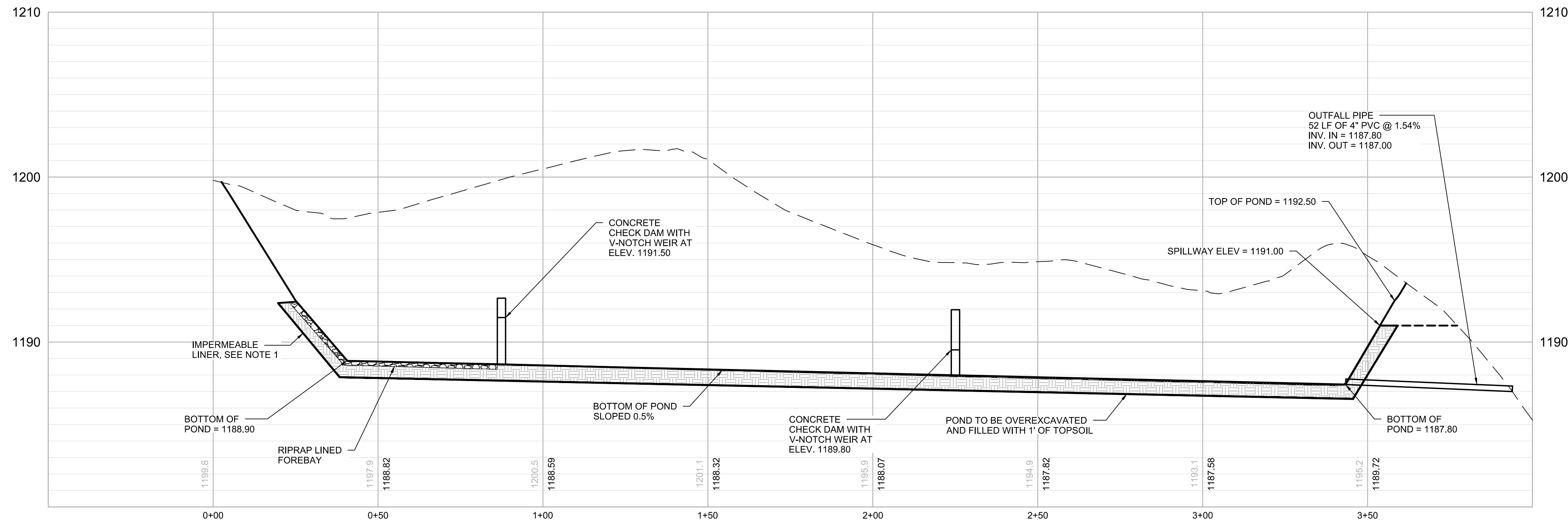
GENERAL NOTES:

- SEE SHEET C101 FOR OVERALL PLAN.
- ALL TIE-IN GRADING SLOPES ARE 3H:1V.
- ALL BASIN SIDE SLOPES ARE 3H:1V.
- SEE DETAIL 2, SHEET C507 FOR RISER STRUCTURES. SEDIMENT BASIN CMP RISERS AND BARRELS WILL BE REMOVED AND REPLACED WITH CONCRETE 4'x4' STRUCTURES AND RCP BARRELS.
- ALL IMPROVEMENTS SHOWN ON THIS SHEET ARE PROPOSED TO BE PERMANENT FOR BASINS AND SWALES EXCAVATED INTO ROCK. UTILIZE AN IMPERMEABLE LINER OF 24" DEEP CLAY OR GEOTEXTILE. THE LINER MUST EXTEND ABOVE THE ELEVATION OF THE EMERGENCY OUTFALL AND MUST BE PROTECTED FROM UPGRADIENT DRAINAGE RUNNING DOWNSLOPE INTO THE BASIN. COVER WITH TOPSOIL. UTILIZE EROSION CONTROL MATTING, AND SEED. FOR SWALES THAT ARE EXCAVATED WHERE ROCK IS NOT ENCOUNTERED DURING EXCAVATION, CONTRACTOR SHALL PROBE SWALE TO ENSURE MINIMUM 24" TO BEDROCK.





WET SWALE 11

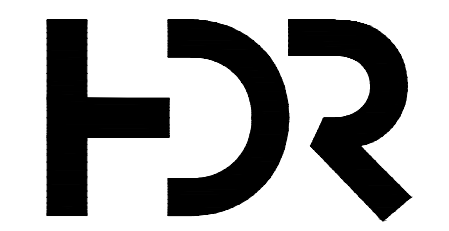


WET SWALE 11

NOTE:

1. FOR BASINS AND SWALES EXCAVATED INTO ROCK, OR WITHIN 2 FEET OF BEDROCK, UTILIZE AN IMPERMEABLE LINER OF 24" DEEP CLAY OR GEOTEXTILE. THE LINER MUST EXTEND ABOVE THE ELEVATION OF THE EMERGENCY OUTFALL AND MUST BE PROTECTED FROM UPGRADIENT DRAINAGE RUNNING DOWNSLOPE INTO THE BASIN. COVER WITH TOPSOIL. UTILIZE EROSION CONTROL MATTING, AND SEED. FOR SWALES THAT ARE EXCAVATED WHERE ROCK IS NOT ENCOUNTERED DURING EXCAVATION, CONTRACTOR SHALL PROBE SWALE TO ENSURE MINIMUM 24" TO BEDROCK.
