Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA) §16-50j-62(b), your request to modify project construction hours from:

Between November 1 and March 31, Monday through Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and between April 1 and October 31, Monday through Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

to

Between November 1 and March 31, Monday through Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and between April 1 and October 31 Monday through Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. is hereby approved.

This approval applies only to the Partial D&M Plan III revision dated April 23, 2024.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling and approved D&M Plan are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Furthermore, the facility owner/operator is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to RCSA §16-50j-62.
