RE: **PETITION NO. 1443** - SR North Stonington, LLC petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to

Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a 9.9-megawatt AC solar photovoltaic electric generating facility on five parcels located north and south of Providence New London Turnpike (State Route 184), west of Boombridge Road and north of Interstate 95 in North Stonington, Connecticut, and associated

electrical interconnection.

Continuation of Evidentiary Hearing

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) shall continue the evidentiary hearing session for the above-referenced proceeding on **Thursday**, **July 8**, **2021**, via Zoom conferencing, beginning at **2:00 p.m.** A copy of the Instructions for Access to the Continued Evidentiary Hearing is attached.

The hearing shall continue with the cross examination of the Petitioner by the Council, followed by further cross examination of the Petitioner by the Town of North Stonington. Thereafter, the hearing will continue with the appearance of the Town of North Stonington for cross examination by the Council and the Petitioner.

Petitioner's Late-Filed Exhibits

During the June 8, 2021 evidentiary hearing session, the Council requested that the Petitioner submit the following information as late-filed exhibits:

- a) Difference in cost between the originally proposed project and the revised project;
- b) Incremental cost to underground all of the on-site electrical interconnection routes from the solar facility to the point of interconnection (e.g. a riser near the existing Eversource distribution line);
- c) The MW AC of each of the four solar array areas (that would total about 9.9 MW AC);
- d) The post-construction percent development areas for the Critical Terrestrial Habitats for Vernal Pool 1 and Vernal Pool E; and
- e) Similar drawing (with distances to nearest residences and property lines) as response to interrogatory #10, Attachment 6 that depicts the <u>originally proposed project</u>.

The Council requests these late-filed exhibits be submitted to the Council before the close of business on **July 1, 2021.**

Any request for an extension of time to submit the above-referenced late-filed exhibits, pre-filed testimony and responses to interrogatories shall be submitted to the Council in writing pursuant to §16-50j-22a of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies
