The Eversource engineering team has reviewed the comments issued by the State of CT sitting council. Eversource has concluded the original legacy design can be updated to current standards which would eliminate the need for the 3rd clean pole; current standards no longer require a clean pole for future DTT/telecom connections. In regards to pole size & above ground connections due to the scope of this interconnection the remainder of the current design must remain as originally designed.

Hi Kerry,

Per the Decision and Order Approving the North Stonington project, attached for reference, we have to submit a Development and Management Plan (D&M) for this site in compliance with Sections 16-50j-60 through 16-50j-62 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies. One of the requirements of the D&M Plan that we have to submit is:

Consultation with Eversource to minimize the visibility of the electrical interconnection and submission of final design plans

This verbiage can be found on page 47 under 2.c.

During the project hearing process, CT Siting Council requested us to petition Eversource to underground the interconnection poles (the three new poles to be installed) and Eversource declined to do so. The height of the poles that Eversource testified they were using are 50 feet tall so if the height is now less than 50 or there are any other mechanisms that demonstrate positive change, that will be beneficial to understand.
