RE: **PETITION NO. 1443A** - SR North Stonington, LLC declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a 9.9-megawatt AC solar photovoltaic electric generating facility on five parcels located north and south of Providence New London Turnpike (State Route 184), west of Boombridge Road and north of Interstate 95 in North Stonington, Connecticut, and associated electrical interconnection. **Temporary Partial D&M Plan II Revision.** 

Dear Attorney Baldwin:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated March 17 and 20, 2023 regarding the temporary revision to Partial Development and Management (D&M) Plan II for the above-referenced site that was approved by the Council on February 17, 2023.

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA) §16-50j-62(b), your request to modify the access road crossing for the eastern array to include two 30-inch (minimum) diameter high density polyethylene pipes as a temporary culvert due to delay in delivery of the approved open-bottom arch culvert is hereby approved. The limits of disturbance associated with the temporary culvert crossing will not exceed the approved disturbance area associated with the permanent arch culvert crossing.

This approval applies only to the temporary Partial D&M Plan II revision dated March 17 and 20, 2023.

Please be advised that deviations from the Council's D&M Plan approvals are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u. Furthermore, the facility owner/operator is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to RCSA §16-50j-62.
