PETITION NO. 1448 - The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for proposed modifications to its existing Card Substation located at 181 Card Street, Lebanon, Connecticut.

Dear Ms. Shanley:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated August 9, 2022, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced declaratory ruling that was issued by the Council on June 4, 2021.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling, your request to perform work from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on the following Sundays: August 14, 21, and 28, 2022 is hereby approved. The Sunday work hours are necessary to complete pre-outage work ahead of approved outages scheduled to commence at the end of August.

Work will be performed inside the existing substation yard and the new and existing control houses.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated August 9, 2022. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Ms. Bachman,

Good morning. Eversource Energy is requesting Sunday work hours for the work at Card Street Substation in Lebanon on the following list of Sundays in order to facilitate the safe and thorough completion of pre-outage work ahead of the CONVEX approved outages beginning at the end of August. The project schedule has been severely impacted as a result of multiple delays to major equipment manufacturer lead times as well as emergent equipment repairs/replacements discovered at the existing substation. These emergent items (i.e., station service components) are required to be properly fixed or replaced prior to the commencement of the project's outage sequence.

Due to the current project timeline, the following Sundays are being requested to facilitate the timely completion of these activities as to not delay the CONVEX approved outage dates and the associated project completion date:

The list of dates includes: August 14th, August 21st and August 28th.

The work involved with this request will take place inside the existing substation yard and the new and existing relay & control enclosure buildings. There will be no use of major construction equipment during this time. Municipal officials have been notified and have expressed no concerns. Abutting property owners will be notified ahead of the work.
