The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated June 20, 2023, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced Declaratory Ruling that was issued by the Council on June 4, 2021.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling, your request to perform work from 8:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 25, 2023 is hereby approved. The extended work hours are necessary to perform repair work on a circuit breaker during an outage.

This approval applies only to the request for temporary changes to work hours dated June 20, 2023.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Subject: Petition No. 1448 - Card Substation - Request for Sunday Work Hours

Dear Ms. Bachman:

Eversource Energy is requesting Siting Council staff review and approval for extended work hours of 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. for the above-referenced project on Sunday, June 25, 2023. The additional extended hours are needed to replace a damaged part inside of the bushing of the 345-kilovolt circuit breaker that was installed under Petition No. 1448. Due to the damaged part, the circuit breaker is out of service. The repair needs to be completed during the current outage window, which is planned to end on June 27, 2023. All work will be conducted within the substation and on Eversource's property. All efforts will be taken to reduce construction noise levels on Sunday by completing the bulk of the repair activities during normal working hours.

Eversource representatives discussed the planned Sunday work with the Town of Lebanon and the Town had no objection to the proposed construction schedule. We will continue to work with the Town and nearby residents to apprise them of the work and to resolve any potential conflicts or concerns.
