The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the correspondence dated January 31, 2023, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced declaratory ruling that was issued by the Council on June 4, 2021.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling, your request to perform work from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on the following Sundays – February 5 and 12, 2023 is hereby approved. The extended work hours are necessary to complete work within the substation yard and control house during a scheduled outage.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated January 31, 2023.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council in the Declaratory Ruling are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Request for Sunday Work Hours

Dear Ms. Bachman:

Eversource Energy is requesting Siting Council staff review and approval for extended work hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. for the above-referenced project on Sunday, February 5, 2023, and Sunday, February 12, 2023. This request is necessary to be able to complete the work within the current outage window, which has been extended from February 10, 2023 to February 13, 2023.

The additional extended hours are needed to in order to properly install and commission the new pass breaker, which is taking longer than expected due to some minor damage to new equipment components and the resultant repair work. The work involved with this request will take place primarily in the new and existing relay and control enclosure building and control cabinet of the new breaker and will consist of wiring, testing, and commissioning. There will be no use of major equipment during this time (no back-up alarms, manlift operations, or equipment operation).

We have notified the Town of Lebanon of our intention to submit this request to the Council. We will continue to work with the Town and nearby residents to apprise them of the work and to resolve any potential conflicts or concerns.
